These high-diversity summer and fall blends have drastically changed not only my soil quality, but also lowered my input costs, and increased the amount of food that I can fit on my property.



What is your property lacking?

When I visit with new clients to work on or walk their property, I often find most properties are only at 15-20% of their potential for most hunters' goals which is to harvest bucks in the top 10% in their area. Mature bucks in pressured states are focused on one thing during fall, staying alive!

The smaller the property, the more every inch of your property needs to be maximized towards better deer habitat.

So how do we reach these goals? We start with your limited resource, or weakest link in the property, and work out from that point.

If your woods look anything like this, then you have a pass-through nighttime feeding and bedding area on your property.

But, within one year you can transform a deer desert (as pictured below on the left), into a highly productive bedding area for both bucks and doe's (pictured on the right) where they feel comfortable moving in daylight and have ample cover and diversity in browse.





How long do deer stay in beds, and why is it important to know?

After running trail cameras on and around beds, I have learned many things, but the most important thing I have learned is how long a deer spends bedded. I have never observed a deer bedded down for more than 1 hour and 45 minutes before getting up to browse around. It takes a deer roughly 30 minutes to fill their first stomach and their diet is 70% browse. So why is this important to know for a small landowner? Well, If you are not providing enough quality browse and security cover within an area where deer naturally want to bed, they will use it to bed down at night, or travel through it at night, while moving to your neighbor's place that has security cover and browse they want and stay on that property during daylight hours.
